## **Tuesday tours of the Museum Store in Berkhamsted are making a comeback.**

The tour aims to give people the chance to see what goes on behind the scenes at the museum.

Organised by Dacorum Heritage Trust, the public can get up close and personal with more than 2,000 treasures found across the borough.

The array of relics include ancient funerary pottery discovered by school children and sketchbooks used by soldiers.

"The tours are an ideal way for people to find out more about Dacorum, and its history," said Richard Lewis, the museum curator.

Starting in November, with a general tour of the store, they will be given regularly on the second Tuesday of each month on a wide variety of themes.

The next is at 2pm, Tuesday, November 13.

To visit the museum on Clarence Road places need to be booked in advance.
